

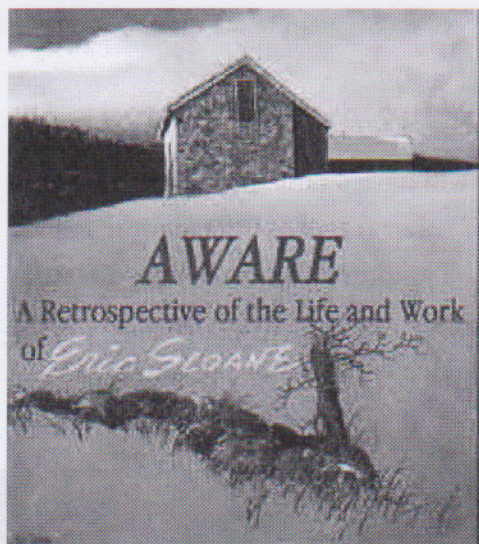
The Noah Blake Cabin to Receive Needed Repairs

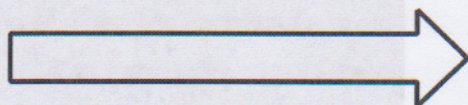
